

Weekly Net Scripts - Non Emergency

*(At 1915 hrs, using the Kenwood radio on VHF Channel 2, initiate alert tones. Net Control Supervisor will advise how this is done. Do this twice, pausing in between to allow the Santiago Peak repeater to perform its alert transmit function. While still on channel 2, **(give your call sign)**)*

After giving your call sign, change the radio to channel 1 and begin the following script:

2 Meter Net Script.

QST QST QST This is *(your call sign)*. Net Control Station for the Huntington Beach Radio Amateur Civil Emergency Service. During emergency activation only, this station will identify as "**W6KRW, Station Huntington Beach.**" Please direct all traffic through this station.

Is there any priority or emergency traffic for the Net?

(long break) (note stations with traffic here)

Are there any bulletins or messages for the Net?

RACES roll call follows.

(roll call) (ask for check-ins using call sign suffixes to split up the membership list.) "Alpha thru Golf," "Hotel thru November," "Oscar thru Tango," and "Uniform thru Zulu." Remember to acknowledge members responding. Use "Roll Call" list in the membership section of the website to check off the members responding. After completing RACES, use the same procedure for CERT. By FCC rules, your call sign must be given at least every 10 minutes. If it will take longer than 10 minutes to call roll, so be sure you identify yourself during the call of sections at least once.

Are there any visitors or RACES candidates to check in?

(Make note of call sign for follow up.)

Are there any missed or late RACES or CERT members to check into the net?
